



Industry will contribute nearly \$60 Million to Ontario's Municipal Blue Box Program in 2005

TORONTO (June 29, 2005)—Industry funding for Ontario's municipal blue box system has entered its second year. As specified in the Waste Diversion Ontario-Stewardship Ontario Blue Box Program Plan, the companies which generate packaging and printed paper that end up in the municipal waste management system will directly contribute \$59 million in 2005 to help pay for municipal blue box recycling programs.

Of the \$59 million, \$8 million is earmarked in 2005 to provide advertising space in daily and community newspapers and, under the Effectiveness and Efficiency Fund which is managed by Stewardship Ontario, to finance activities designed to increase recycling rates and reduce recycling program costs.

“This year's contribution is in addition to the \$34 million industry contributed to the blue box program last year, bringing the total over two years to \$93 million,” said Damian Bassett, CEO of Stewardship Ontario, the organization responsible for collecting the money from industry and distributing it to municipalities.

The money is collected from companies, called ‘stewards,’ as fees. The amount each steward pays is based on the quantity and type of packaging material and printed paper the company introduces into the Ontario marketplace and that is managed by municipalities' waste services. Examples of the packaging and paper include not only glass, plastic and metal food and beverage containers but also other types of plastic packaging including blister packs and bags for retail stores and grocery stores, as well as packaging for food such as bread, milk and special uses such as garden soil. Also included are paper products like newspapers, flyers, magazines, catalogues, instruction manuals, reports, junk mail, direct mail and boxes of all types.

The funding for this year is being distributed to municipalities in quarterly payments beginning on June 30, 2005. The last payment for 2005 will be forwarded in March 2006. The funding will continue annually as specified under Ontario's *Waste Diversion Act, 2002*.

The amount each municipal program receives is determined by a number of factors including the range of materials they collect and the tonnage each diverts from disposal.

Under the *Waste Diversion Act, 2002*, companies that are brand owners and first importers of designated packaging and printed paper are required to fund 50% of the net cost of municipal residential Blue Box recycling programs. Municipalities pay the remainder of the costs through their tax bases.

“This industry-municipal, cost-sharing program is unique to Ontario. When both parties pay, it ensures each has an interest in keeping the Blue Box recycling program efficient and cost-effective,” said Glenda Gies, Executive Director of Waste Diversion Ontario, which is an organization created under the *Waste Diversion Act* to oversee waste diversion programs. In addition to ‘Blue Box Wastes,’ it is responsible for creating diversion plans for used oil, used tires and used electrical and electronic equipment.

“Overall, our objectives are to help pay for the Blue Box recycling program in Ontario so that it remains fiscally viable as an integral tool in the municipal waste management system to divert natural resources from disposal,” Bassett said, “and to encourage people to recycle everything they possible can whether they are at home or the cottage, at the office or school, or strolling around their community. Recycling should always be the choice over disposal.”
